## **What Can I Take at SECCA?**

### **High School CTAE (Career/Technical/Agricultural Education) Electives** (student receives high school credit):

Students may take advantage of courses not currently being taught in their high school by attending one of the other three high schools in the partnership for a portion of the school day. Any high school student is eligible for these courses.

### ***A new course in Automotive Technology/Automotive Mechanics will be available second semester 2009.***

- Course will be taught 7 periods daily.
- Course is open to students enrolled in Toombs County High School, Montgomery County High School, Treutlen County High School, and Vidalia High School.
- High school students may enroll for 1, 2, or 3 class periods per day.
- Course will be taught by a highly qualified instructor.

A new Automotive Technology Program is coming to Southeastern Technical College next year. Through this program, high school students can get a head start!! Our region needs trained automotive technicians.
